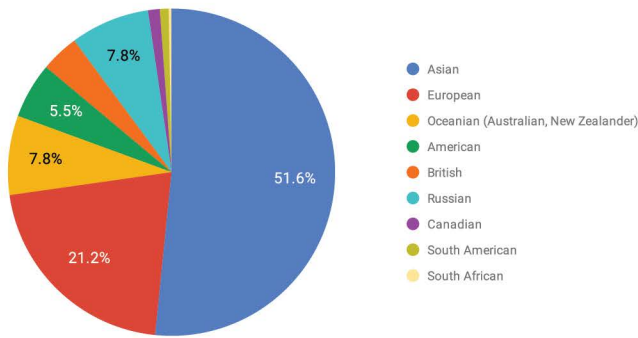

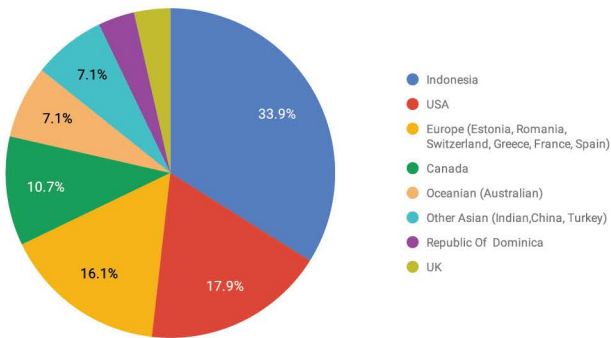

If a student fulfills the following requirements, they will be awarded a BIS High School Diploma

BIS HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS:

In Grade 9-12 students must:

- Achieve a minimum grade of 3* or higher in:
 - English (Language and Literature, Literature or Language Acquisition)
 - A second language (Language and Literature or Language Acquisition)
 - Individuals and Societies
 - Science
 - Mathematics
 - Arts (G9-12) or in Grade 11/12 an additional Science or Individuals and Societies subject

Over four semesters in Grade 9-10 students must:

- Achieve a minimum grade of 3* or higher in:
 - Physical and health education

Additional requirements:

- Meet Service as Action (G9&10) and CAS requirements (G11&12)
- Meet school attendance requirements

REPORTING AND GRADING

- IB grading system from 1-7
- BIS does not rank students, calculate GPAs or award credits.
- Reporting Periods: December and June
